Elmore County Opening “Warming Stations”

Elmore County – The Elmore County Emergency Management Agency, in coordination with many of our partners, is announcing the opening of six “Warming Stations” in Elmore County, beginning this evening in response to the extremely cold weather forecasted for our area overnight until mid-morning on January 8th.

Please note: “Warming Stations” **ARE NOT** shelters. Individuals may stop by to “warm up” and get out of the frigid cold for a period of time, but there should be no expectation of the host site providing meals/beverages, showers, bedding, etc., during the individual’s short stay.

The following **six locations** will open beginning this evening (**see times and locations below**) for anyone lacking sufficient heating and warmth from the frigid temperatures expected to dominate our area through mid-morning tomorrow.

Tallassee First United Methodist Church – Corner of Jordan Avenue and Barnett Blvd. **OPEN:** Jan 7th from 6:30 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. Jan 8th

First Presbyterian Church, Wetumpka – 100 West Bridge Street. **OPEN:** Jan 7th from 8:00 p.m. until mid-morning Jan 8th

St. James Baptist Church – 1005 Nobles Rd. Wetumpka. **OPEN:** Jan 7th from 7:00 p.m. until mid-morning Jan 8th
